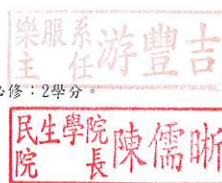

 - ◇C 領域課程—樂齡生活規劃
- 若就讀專班所已停辦，原應修原住民文化相關課程及建構原民知識(傳統)學習模組課程等必修30學分課程未取得時，得以改修本校相對應系所規劃之專業課程替代。
- 畢業年級相當於國內高級中等學校二年級之國外或香港、澳門同類同級學校畢業生，以同等學歷修讀本校學士學位者，最低畢業學分：140學分(學分含跨系20學分)；必修學分：81學分；選修學分：59學分(選修學分含跨系選修學分)，惟於本系專業選修學分不得低於47學分，可延長修業年限三年。

- Students shall take 4 hours Service Education courses (0 credits) in the first and second semester of the first academic year.
- In the first three years, students must take 16-30 credits per semester, and 9-30 credits per semester in the 4th year.
- Minimum credits required for graduation: 128 credits including 81 compulsory credits, and at least 47 elective credits. Technical English(I)(II)・Applied English(I)(II)・school professional required courses, department compulsory and department elective courses.)
- Students must have skill practice in a senior citizen service organization in the second semester in their senior year.
- The three Field Courses are:
 - ◇ Field A Courses -- Smart Care Management
 - ◇ Field B Courses-- Geriatric Social Work
 - ◇ Field C Course -- Planning for Retired Life.
- If the MUST Curriculum Planning for Undergraduate Indigenous Students has been discontinued, students should have taken courses related to indigenous culture and the construction of indigenous knowledge (traditional) learning module courses, etc. If the compulsory 30-credit course is not obtained, it can be replaced by taking professional courses planned by the corresponding department of the school.
- Students having graduated from a foreign country, including Hong Kong and Macau, with the equivalent of the second year of high school study of the ROC's high school sophomore level, or with a high school equivalent degree, need to take 140 credits including 81 compulsory credits, and at least 59 elective credits (including inter-departmental elective credits), while elective professional course credits shall not be fewer than 47. The program can be extended up to 3 academic years.
- Elective courses are subject to change if necessary.
