[Tradition and Innovation in Museum Collections]

Collections—the essential mission and role of museums traditionally—are major features that set museums apart from other cultural organizations. Novel advocacy and practices spring forth from cumulative knowledge in the museum collection domain as a response to constant technological innovation, social development, and public demand. It is noteworthy that in addition to dutifully managing and preserving collected artifacts, numerous museums have already initiated actions related to sustainability, management efficiency, and other topics with regard to collection management and maintenance. Influenced by the idea of "as open as possible, as closed as necessary" and technological progress, multiple museums are gradually licensing non-free images under an "as open as possible, as closed as necessary" policy to make them available free of charge. Research on digital culture and technological methods helps uncover new meanings of collected artifacts and foster digital and diverse applications of such. A considerable number of museums is also adopting perspectives like egalitarianism, decentralization, and democracy to promote contemporary collection. Alliances with communitybased organizations enable closeness with communities and the general public, facilitating the compiling and interpretation of stories and objects belonging to contemporary people, and opening a dialogue with existing collected artifacts in museums. All these are prime examples of how museum employees showcase creativity and blaze new trails under the museum collection tradition. This issue of ARTISTICA TNNUA calls for research on matters related to the collection domain in museums, ranging from tradition to innovation and including advocacy, practice, discussion, and reflection.
